Please pray for our family as we are trying to process the papers for the adoption of Abigail. Since our early return from the States, at their request, they basically have done nothing. We have ran into many frustrations along the way. There has been much dishonesty and many misleading which has brought a great deal of frustration. We still have not been granted legal custody of her even though we she was given to us the first week of March. We were recently told that they have to exhaust every avenue to prevent the adoption before granting it. However, we will wait patiently on the Lord to work it out in His good timing. Abigail has improved in health tremendously and we are thankful for that. She is a beloved part of our family now. Amy and the kids adore her and well, you know what they say about "daddy's girls"!

Born in a Toilet but Destined for the Throne!

Patrick Jayme was moved to share his testimony with us as a result of the revival. While he was yet in his mothers womb, she did not want a child. For months she had tied a towel tightly around her waist and stomach trying to hide the fact of her pregnancy. As a result Patrick never fully developed as he should. In a final attempt to get rid of this child, she gave birth to Patrick in a toilet (literally in the bowl) and wanted to leave him there but was caught and forced to take him.

Due to a lack of prenatal care Patrick was born deaf, stunted growth and very small. He was neglected as a child. Being born deaf he was always considered a liability to the family and was forced to be as a family servant. Throughout his life he had been holding hard feelings toward his mother and family.

Now Patrick is attending our Deaf Bible Institute. He wants to serve the Lord with a pure heart which required him to forgive his mother and family.

He badly needs your prayers and possible support. His family refuses to help him pursue any service for the Lord. They will not assist him financially or give him food either. If you would like to help Patrick continue his schooling through a student sponsorship program please let us know and we will get you the needed information.
