Spring / Summer 2012

Dear Praying Friends,

Our weather has been hot and dry, averaging around 90 degrees. We have had very little rain. Please pray for rain.

We held an activity at an orphanage at the end of April. This orphanage is state run and is about 15 minutes from our village. We are hoping to have more activities at the orphanage in the future, but this requires us to obtain permission again from the social services. As of now, we have not received approval to have any more activities. Please pray for this door to open for us.

During the children's Easter week vacation, we had spring day camp. There were 14 children and teens who attended.

Our church services and activities have been averaging around 25 over the past month, with 66 different children who have attended during this same time period. Costel and Lenuta continue to attend faithfully. Please pray for more of the children to attend faithfully, and for more adults to attend.

We had our first summer day camp this past week. There were 20 who attended, 10 boys and 10 girls. We are planning to have another day camp toward the end of the summer. Several of the children attended camp for the first time.

This year, we will not be taking our children to the camp in Bihor like we did last year. We are trying to keep our expenses down, so we can hopefully apply some monies toward the multi-purpose building project. Having day camps at our location saves us money. It also allows more children to attend camp. Bihor is 12 hours away by van, and gasoline here in Romania is about \$7 a

gallon.

We have received \$1550 toward the multi-purpose building. Please pray for the rest of the needed funds to come in quickly. Right now, we are receiving a good exchange rate against the Romanian currency. In fact, it is the highest exchange rate we have had since we arrived in Romania in 1999. This allows us to purchase materials at a lower price.

Marianne will be having abdominal surgery within the next few weeks. Please pray that everything will go well.

Please pray for our support needs. We need \$825 more per month to be fully supported.
