#### **2012 PROJECTS**

- 1. **Security Wall**: We need to place a security wall around our property. Currently we are using a bamboo fencing that is constantly being broken through by neighborhood mischief.

  Need: \$17,000
- 2. **Student Dormitory**: We currently have our female staff and students living off campus which poses constant security issues. As well as, the area in which they are located floods terribly when typhoons come through thus hindering their ability to get in and out.

  Need: \$10,000
- 3. **Kitchen**: We currently cook over open fire using wood and charcoal in a native bamboo kitchen. We are constantly being called upon to host conferences but are unable to do so due to inadequate facilities to prepare the meals.

  Need: \$10,000
- 4. **Campus Restroom**: We currently have one toilet for the entire church use. This is used by both male and female. The line gets long! **Need: \$8,000**
- 5. **Family/Ministry 4x4 Vehicle**: We want to be able to go visit our church planters that are sent out of our church. We want to encourage these church planters as well as hold them accountable with the investment that many are making in their ministries.

Need: \$20,000

6. **Family Apartment**: Due to contract limitations on rentals, we have lived in eighteen different houses in seventeen years of missions. We have lost multiple thousands of dollars in rent and non-refundable deposits. We now have property of our own as a ministry. We would like to build an apartment for our family on the church property for a permanent place to live.

Need: \$30,000
