It would have been about \$15,000 for one that was in decent shape and ten years old. However, we continued to explore our options and found that we could purchase a much larger and nicer one from the USA and only pay a fraction of the cost, even after shipping. With some money already given by churches for the bus, we were able to purchase a 2001 Chevy, 20 passenger diesel for \$2,000! It only has about 130,000 miles on it! The Lord has worked a miracle and it looks we should have just about enough money to transport the bus down to El Salvador, though



we are still working on exact price quotes. Here are some other upcoming projects if the Lord puts it on your heart to help in supplying for these needs.

- Painting the "new" bus \$1,000
- Improvement on our hospitality apartment -\$1,000 (in addition to \$2,000 already given)
- New roof for 7-9 grade building \$5,000
