(Hopefully we will learn a little bit more French! I praise God that Bruce had French in high school and can recognize enough to help already!)

Two big prayer requests for this weekend:

- 2) Pray for us to find a reliable taxi driver who can help us (by knowing English) and by working for us, as needed, the next two weeks. We have a lot of survey work to do in order to make this time in Gabon successful.

FYI: There is a five hour time difference between Gabon and the east coast of the USA. So we are five hours later than your time. (In other words... ADD 5 hours to your time and that is what time it is here.)
