Dear Praying Friends,

Our attendance continues to average around 30 for each service and activity. Bogdan, the 24-year-old physically-handicapped man, continues to attend faithfully.

We conducted two day camps this summer. Each camp was for three days. The first camp was in August and was for our faithful children and teen attenders. The second camp was for teens only and was held the beginning of September before school started.

As we mentioned in our last prayer letter, Marianne had a complete right knee replacement in May. She developed a hypertrophic scar as a result of the surgery. The scar is better, but it still is not completely healed. She experiences extreme sensitivity and burning sensations at the scar area. She has been to the surgeon and also a dermatologist about the condition. Please pray that this condition will be healed.

Bob had a repeat CT scan at the end of July. This scan revealed that the hormone therapy worked effectively. He is now ready to undergo a prostatectomy on October 8. He will be in the hospital for about five days. Please pray that all will go well-- that there will be no complications, that the recovery will be speedy and complete and that the surgery will result in Bob being cancer free.

This spring we are hoping to begin work on step one of the multipurpose building project. Once Bob has the surgery, he will not need to continue with the hormone therapy. This will allow his strength and energy to return. Step one will be to buy and put in place the poles that will support the sides and the roof. Then the entire building area would need to be cemented. This step will cost \$10,000. The total project is estimated at \$31,500. The multipurpose building will be a tremendous help in reaching our area with the Gospel. It will also aid us in reaching older teens and adults.
