Dear Pastors, Partners, & Praying Friends,

As we close out the month of August, we trust everyone is doing well. As always, we keep you in our prayers and always look forward to hearing what the Lord is graciously doing on your end. Please allow us the opportunity to share with you what the Lord has done for us in August 2013!

"Where He Leads Me I Will Follow," is a song that has stood out to us this month. As you are aware we began deputation in April of this year and only had four meetings from April through July. That changed quickly as the month of August has seen us on the road every week traveling to present our burden in a different church every Sunday and Wednesday. The Lord also allowed us to be in two missions conferences this month. The Lord led us to the states of Georgia, Tennessee, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Virginia.
