We would also like to thank you all for praying with us regarding the Sanguera land project. A special thanks to those of you whom the Lord used to provide the payment. We were able to pay for the second lot in full on August 24. We have also started on the paper works for the land which will take a few months. The deed will be in the name of the Lord's ministry through us, Chapelle Baptiste (i.e. Chapel Baptist in French). We will keep you posted. We are very grateful to the Lord and to all of you! Now we are praying for the Lord to guide us as to how we should use the land and the wherewithal to fully exploit it.

Please pray for our mission board at this time of change in the leadership. The Lord called home last month, Dr. Ellis, who faithfully served as the president of the mission board for 31 years. We may need to travel to the US next year in order to attend the annual Jubilee and be part of an important meeting.

School starts here on Monday, October 7. We are prayerfully looking forward to it as the Lord may grant us new opportunities of being witnesses of Him to school children and of leading many of them to Him.

Please keep praying with us regarding the children ministry that we have always mentioned to you about. It is a heavy burden on our hearts especially for children here in Sanguera. With the ministry land with which the Lord has blessed us, we now have the place to hold children activities. All that is left now is the preparation of the land and some game equipment for children activities. We have already got some of the equipment.

Thank you for praying for peaceful legislative elections for us. They went well and they were peaceful. Thank you!

The music course also went well. One of our newly converts by the name of Valère seems to be the one whom the Lord is preparing to help me with the music ministry in the church. Please uphold him in prayer.
