For an eternal salvation - We saw five adults and five children receive Christ as their personal Saviour during invitation times since our last update.

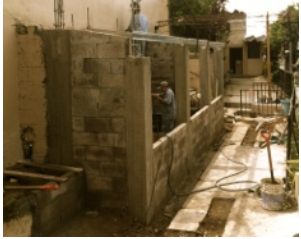
