We met a young man in October who just graduated from West Coast who is doing an internship that feels a calling for Japan. How exciting it would be to work with this young man if the Lord continues to guide, lead, and direct in that way. People are being saved and baptized as well as getting on fire for serving the Lord. What a mighty God we serve!

Currently we stand at 7.5% of our needed support for Japan. Praise the Lord that in the month of October we had one church take us on for support and two other churches stating they would let us know towards the end of the year. Thank you once again to everyone who has given on our behalf.

During October, we traveled a total of 2,921 miles, were in 8 different churches, and 5 different states. Everyone is traveling well and we are excited to continue to see what the Lord will do as we magnify the Lord by ministering to others on deputation.
