EVERYTHING POINTS TO CALVARY

Christ Jesus made peace through the blood of His cross.

Did you know that Calvary existed before the foundation of the world? Yes, Calvary existed in the mind of God before the world was ever created. Here is a verse with that in context: Rev 13:8 And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world. There is a most interesting thought generated in this statement that can be liked to Gen 1:26-27 where Scripture says, So God created man in his own image So what does it mean to be made in the image and likeness of God? When God created Adam, he was made in the form of That which already existed. The thought here could be expressed as carving a sculpture from a live pose. Think of it this way: Before a sculpture of Abraham Lincoln could be carved, he had to exist. Rev 13:8 describes the physical body of Jesus being crucified on the cross before the world or man was ever created. Part of man being made in the image of God had to do with a body that already existed. This preexistent bodily form of Jesus when He appeared to men is called a Christophany.

It is first found in Gen 3:8 as the Lord Jesus walked with man in the garden in the cool of the day. Another of many Christophanies occurred when the Lord Jesus appeared to Abraham in Genesis 18. Man's image and likeness of God was effaced by sin, but not erased. Those who willingly come to Calvary would once again be created in the image of God. Calvary not only made it possible to walk with the Lord, but never to walk without Him. Part of man's salvation has to do with this image of our Creator being restored: Rom 8:29 For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son. 1Jon 3:2 Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is. Praise the Lord! Yes, everything truly points to Calvary. From Genesis to Revelation Calvary is the message of God's great love for man. We owe it all to Calvary, that is, to the One who was crucified there and took our place. Make much of Calvary! If any man glory, let him glory in the blood of His cross.

Andrew, the young (29 now) JW who was saved about four years ago through the hotline ministry, lived just an hour's drive from their location. He was eager and well prepared to be my "Timothy." It never ceases to amaze me to see how the Lord keeps His hand upon our lives. Had I attempted to make that trip, my car would have broken down on the highway about midway and the meeting would have been cancelled. I just love how the sweet Lord watches over us. He is awesome and ever faithful in protecting us from the pitfalls that would hinder His will.

The meeting lasted four hours and ended in denial. Checkmated four times without recourse, William was determined to return to the WT. His brother, who had remained a faithful JW, was the one who convinced him to return and work door-to-door with him with the hope of becoming a fulltime JW missionary. A saved, brokenhearted wife with two small children is now facing a very difficult trial. Please pray!
