The year certainly ended on a very high note! We reached our goal of 50% support level before the year ended, thanks to 3 new supporting churches in the month of December. At Thanksgiving, we found out we were going to be grandparents again in July. Then, at Christmas, we found out we are also going to be grandparents again in August! What a blessing! We are so excited for our children and will look forward to having a total of 6 grandchildren next Christmas.

West Africa Trip

I mentioned last month that I will be traveling to Liberia & Ghana Jan. 9-22. God has provided all the finances to pay for this trip! What a blessing! I will be meeting with the students of our 3 different Bible Colleges as they begin their second semester of classes. We thank God for a good first semester, but there are several things that need to be worked out in person and not through email.

I will be getting estimated costs to finish the well, septic system, and inside of the building we purchased. This building is where we plan to live and start a church in Tinker Village, Liberia.

Brother Feghaly would like to bring a couple of our national pastors to the U.S. and help them raise some financial support. Therefore, I will be going to the American Embassy in Liberia to see if they will grant them permission to leave the country for a short period of time. I will also be looking into what is necessary for Brenda & me to obtain long-term visas to stay in Liberia after we complete our deputation ministry. *My first visit to the embassy was a police escort for taking pictures! I hope they don't remember me! LOL (There was no problem. They just made me delete the pictures. Interesting experience!)*

As always, I will be preaching as often as possible and trying to encourage the pastors and believers.

New Testament Baptist Colleges

We praise God for the start of NTBC in both Liberia & Ghana! What a blessing to be training men for ministry.
