JESUS CHRIST THE SON OF GOD

He answered and said, Lo, I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire, and they have no hurt; and the form of the fourth is like the Son of God (Dan 3:25).

"The Son of God" appears 44 times in Scripture.

It's God's way of declaring that Jesus Christ is

divine and has the same DNA as His Father.

It has been said by many various anti-Trinitarian groups (especially Jehovah's Witnesses or JWs) "We believe that Jesus is the Son of God." This would mean to each of them that Jesus had some special qualities, but in the same breath they would deny that Jesus is God the Eternal Son. Watchtower (WT) leaders claim (in their *What Does The Bible Really Teach?* book, p. 41) that Jesus was God's *first creation*. If you do a word search for *first*

creation or first created in your Bible, you will not find a match. This idea is a WT invention and not a Biblical statement. Then they go on to say that Jesus was

the only one *directly created by God*. If that were so, then the expression *first creation* would be incorrect because *first* would imply a *second*. The question of the *firstborn* and the *first created* is answered simply and clearly in Chapter 5 of *CHECKMATE for Mormons and Jehovah's Witnesses*. One's understanding of Colossians 1:15-18 makes the John 1:3 checkmate a closed door discussion with the JW left without any hope.

The phrase *Son of God* appears 44 times in the Bible and it is a glorious statement that links Jesus eternally with the Father. Daniel 3:25 is the only reference in the Old Testament and gives place to capturing the glory of the Son of God delivering those who have put their trust in His Word.

This expression *the Son of God* is used 43 times in the New Testament to direct everyone's attention to

the divine nature and essence of Jesus Christ. These many Theophanies or Christophanies (an appearance of Christ before His incarnation) now have a physical presence in Jesus Christ, the Son of God. This verse announces the revelation:

Luke 1:35 And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of

thee shall be called the Son of God.

When Jesus said that He was the Son of God (John 9:35-38),

He declared His oneness in nature and essence with the Father. His enemies understood exactly what He meant with these words: *The Father and I are One* and accused Him of blasphemy: John 10:33 *The Jews answered him, saying, For a good work we stone thee not; but for blasphemy; and because that thou, being a man, makest thyself God.*

Jesus is the fullness of the Godhead bodily, the image of the invisible God, the One who came forth from the bosom of the Father, the only begotten Son, the One who said that if you have seen Him, you have seen His Father, and John said that there are also many other things which Jesus did, the which, if they should be written every one, that even the world itself could not contain the books that should be written. Aren't you so thankful that the Son of God is your LORD and Saviour? Amen!

For nearly 20 years we have used a dual cassette tape answering machine. Pre-owned models from eBay have kept us going until recently, but the sweet Lord has given us an upgrade that's hard to believe. He's an awesome God!



Our AT&T hotline phone bill kept creeping up over the years to a high of \$56 per month. The problem with changing systems was finding an answering machine that had enough memory to record a five minute outgoing message. The Lord took care of both problems in one quick and easy change. Ooma Telo! Now my phone bill per month is \$.00. I pay \$3.45 per month for 911 and taxes. That's all! Wow, wow!!!!! I just called AT&T after porting my number to Ooma as a new carrier and it was done. The Ooma box works with our Wi-Fi on the house line and once it is setup and configured, you're good to go. The Ooma system has 1 gig of memory which give 6 minutes for an outgoing message and many other features that are incredible.

I had run out of ideas of how to improve our hotline system and feared that when our old cassette machine failed it would be over. While on visitation at CrossRoads, a brother was telling me that he no longer pays for his land phone line. I said, "How can that be?" And then along came "Ooma" and now the John 1:3 checkmate is the hotline message at 770-932-3806.
