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WHAT IS YOUR BLESSED HOPE?

And ye now therefore have sorrow: but I will see you again, and your heart shall rejoice, and your joy no man taketh from you (John 16:22).

She was looking for answers to her many questions. I sent her a copy of CHECKMATE and then a few weeks later our tract on How To Have Peace With God. A LOST CAUSE

One of the first burdens that I felt as our work in cult evangelism began to mature was for the people in our Baptist churches. Countless times when I would encounter a JW and ask him where he went to church before he started attending the Kingdom Hall he would say, "I used to be a Baptist." Then I would ask him, "What was it that drew you to the JWs." Without fail this was the reply, "I didn't learn anything in the Baptist church." I began asking the Lord to show me the problem and how to correct it and He did — our Baptist Sunday schools are listening centers rather than learning centers. When a teacher teaches someone the times tables, he can say them, he knows how to use them, and he will continue using them the rest of his life. This is real teaching.

The past tense of teach is taught, not spoke. I looked up the word "teach" and this is the definition: to cause to know. The "cause" requires a minimum of three things: accountability, a sense of need, and application. This is what causes one to learn. In our Sunday schools, we have lost the cause that enables anyone to learn. Without the cause people sit and Every Christian should listen. have been taught the basic doctrines, the 10 commandments, the 6 pieces of armor, 7 things one should add to his faith, the unity and diversity of the Godhead, and the list goes on. This means that if you would ask anyone in a pew they would know these things just like the times tables. The reason they don't is that they have never been taught. Lord please help us!
