## DO YOU HAVE VICTORY IN JESUS?

... Resist the devil [TD], and he will flee from you.

TD is the abbreviation for the underlined words that precede it in the above verse. Many years ago while in Bible College, I took a course called *History of Cults*. At the end of the semester we were required to write a paper on one of the cult groups listed in the index. One chapter on *Spiritism* dealt with the occult. The teacher told a story about a prior student who chose this chapter for the subject of his paper. When he turned his paper in it only had one line, "The liar and deceiver is not worthy of one word of mention." The teacher gave him an A+ on his content and thanked the Lord for the lesson he had learned from this experience.

At different times I have been in services where people were given the opportunity to testify and the first words out of their mouth were TD. Then what followed was some awful story of how he had been troubled and hindered by the TD. This opened the door for others to express their dismay for the same types of oppression. Suddenly the atmosphere changed drastically to frigid. I can recall being in services where the TD words were used more times than Jesus. The question is why? Is there no victory in Jesus? Is there no truth to the promise of victory in these verses? James 4:5-8 *Do ye*

*think that the scripture saith in vain, The spirit that dwelleth in us lusteth to envy?*

*6 But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble.*

*7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.*

*8 Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded.*

Is not He (the Holy Spirit) greater than he (TD) that's in the world? These verses tell us that victory is possible by drawing nigh to God. When we do that the enemy will flee. Why are people these days so easily defeated? They have no armor! Some have suggested that the greatest numbers of people in our churches are defeated because they are undisciplined and unequipped to stand and do the work of the ministry. If this is true, then the church has failed blatantly to obey the Great Commission.

Mark 16:15 *...Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.*

Are we giving adequate time and proven results to both parts of the Lord's command?
