Dear Friends,

Thank you once again for your prayers and interest in our ministry of reaching deaf people around the world with the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

The year 2015 promises to be another blessed year of international ministry. I, David, leave for Romania in one week. I will be in several churches, at least one Bible College, and also attending a conference of Deaf leaders from around Europe.

I will be challenging students with the need of reaching the Deaf in their countries. This is something that I have been doing for sometime, and God is blessing it. Just today I received a note from one young man in India who took one of the Deaf Ministry batons after an invitation I gave in his Bible College in Bangalore three months ago. He has not forgotten what God called him to do.

Please pray for me as I do some survey work in Europe, I speak with Deaf leaders there about the ongoing need to established Deaf ministries and churches in their cities and countries. Labors are desperately needed because the harvest is still vast among the Deaf.

Yesterday, I received a phone call from a national pastor in Nepal. We are beginning to reach some deaf people there, and he had some questions for me. I was able to give him the council and help that he was needing, And share some other important information with him that will be a blessing to their ministry. One of the men who is working with the Deaf in their ministry will be traveling to Calcutta/Kolkata for some further deaf ministry training. What is exciting to me, besides the growth of deaf ministries in Nepal is that the man who will be doing the training is one that I trained myself several years ago! What a blessing to see the ministry multiplied in this way as well... training men who will be able to train other men also!

Pray, too, for Vicki as she keeps the home fires burning. This past week she spoke at the Chattanooga Rescue Mission. This is one of her ministries, and the ladies enjoy learning from her. She is still the joy of my life, and a blessing to me personally. I do not know what I would do without her... is more than just the cliché!

Thank you again for all that you mean to us... as our faithful supporters.
