Subject: Update: April 2015

Our Dear Friends in the Lord,

It is with joy that I write you this update. I would like to start off by thanking you for praying for us. Our Lord really does answer prayer. What a lot we forfeit when we do not pray!

Our Easter Convention this year was a great blessing. The Lord has answered our prayers. All of our churches convened in Agoe for the event. The theme this year was "The Power in the Blood of Jesus!"

People started arriving at the venue as early as 2 in the afternoon on Friday. Some, however, did not arrive until Saturday. As is usually the case on the first day of the Convention, attendance was lowest. But that did in no wise discourage or slow things down. Starting from 4 PM, with singing accompanied by our brass ensemble, we paraded through the community to announce the start of the Convention and to invite people. Over 500 gospel tracts were distributed with invitation cards. At the opening service that Friday evening, 338 people were present.

On Saturday morning, 423 adults were present for the church service. We held a workshop for different groups in the afternoon. The topic for the workshop was "What tool are you for the Lord?" We also grouped over 300 children for the workshop. We held nightly prayer meetings on Friday and Saturday nights from 10 PM to 2 AM.

The attendance during the Easter Sunday service was 483 (children non-included). A few other people from the immediate vicinity stood afar off witnessing the event. The church service was such a blessing. Congregational singing was joyful and the special singing by choirs and other singing groups were simply uplifting. It was especially helpful to me as I was to bring the Easter morning message. The Lord really used me that day. I preached on the Power of Christ to save everywhere. When I gave the invitation, 10 people received Christ. Several rededicated their lives to the Lord. It was such a blessing! Thank you so much for praying for us. We will be in prayer for a much better Easter Convention next year. We're praying that the Lord will send us preachers from the US to come and challenge us next year.

The presidential election in Togo has been moved to April 25. The different political parties are already campaigning. There are 5 candidates vying for the presidency. For now, things are peaceful. Please continue to help us pray for things to go well. We will keep you posted.

Please continue to help us pray for the remaining \$3623.96 for our ministry vehicle. As our work keeps expanding, it becomes increasingly difficult for us to minister without an adequate mode of transportation.

Lord willing, we're planning to travel to the US in June or July in order to visit some of our supporting churches. Please be in much prayer for us as it is quite expensive and it calls for us to have to apply for a visa. We trust the Lord with every procedure.

May the Lord continue to use us for His own glory!
