Greetings from Togo! We are once again nearing the end of another year. We would like to thank every one of you for your faithful support throughout this year by your giving, praying, and encouragement to us in various ways. And the Lord has been good to us in that He has allowed our labor to be fruitful. Thanks to you, 173 souls have been won to the Lord this year. We have noted 63 people baptized. We give all the glory to the Lord. The task is far from being accomplished but we rejoice over what He is doing in and through us.

We would like to thank you for praying for our vehicle need. The Lord has answered our prayers by providing the funds. We were able to pay in full for a preowned 2010 Dodge Caliber. Arrangement is currently underway to have it shipped to us. We're praying for \$1,300 more to help us take care of some shipping costs and part of customs fees when the vehicle gets to Togo. We trust the Lord to provide for this as well.

The Chapelle Baptiste of Sanguera is doing well. The Lord has made provision for us to be able to have the new church building painted. Hopefully, works will start on Monday. Once the painting is finished, we will start working on building the baptistery as there are a few people waiting to be baptized. Thanks to your prayers, the Lord is adding souls to the church. Glory to His name!

We also praise the Lord for providing a motorcycle for Pastor Job, one our district ministry supervisors, through a dear brother. He was in dire need of a motorcycle in order to travel between the five churches that are under his supervision. He and his family were moved to tears by the goodness of the Lord. We're praying that the Lord will do the same for another one of our district supervisors in the northern district. The purchase price (including title, registration, and insurance for the first year) is about \$900.

For the coming years, please help us be in prayer for the construction of church buildings for some of our village works. Our goal is that, if the Lord tarries, we will be able to build solid cement blocks buildings for all of our works. Several of them are in deplorable conditions. It cost about \$3500 to build a church in those areas. We will start with whatever the Lord places in our hands.

May the Lord continue to strengthen and use you as you pray and support His cause!
