THE GREAT DENIAL CONTINUES

The stone which the builders refused is become the head stone of the corner (Ps 118:22).

I wonder, have you ever thought of the context of the above verse? It is really amazing because it is a verse which is so often quoted, yet it is seldom linked to its context. It is a verse that you hear frequently but the application is missing. Here it is; Ps 118:24: This is the day which the LORD hath made: we will rejoice and be glad in it. Rejoice in what? One is to rejoice in that the Stone (Christ) that was rejected has become the Head of the corner. Here's all the verses in order: Ps 118:21-24

21 I will praise thee: for thou hast heard me, and art become my salvation.

22 The stone which the builders refused is become the head stone of the corner. 23 This is the LORD'S doing; it is marvellous in our eyes.

24 This is the day which the LORD hath made; we will rejoice and be glad in it. The resurrected Christ has become the Head of His Church and all whose names are written in the book of life are members of His Body, the Church.

Jesus spoke of this specifically when He was refused or rejected because He said that He is the Son of God which made Him equal with the Father. Take a look of how our Lord used this verse to rebuke those who refused Him. Matt 21:42-44: 42 Jesus saith unto them, Did ye never read in the scriptures, The stone which the builders rejected, the same is become the head of the corner: this is the Lord's doing, and it is marvellous in our eyes? 43 Therefore say I unto you, The kingdom of God shall be taken from you, and given to a nation bringing forth the fruits thereof, 44 And whosoever shall fall on this stone shall be broken: but on whomsoever it shall fall, it will grind him to powder.

Jehovah's Witnesses, Mormons, Seventh-day Adventists, and Muslims all refuse Jesus because being equal with the Father would make Him not only God, but also eternal. Denying that Jesus is the Eternal Son of God is the central doctrine of the great apostasy or the great denial of the last days. You may be surprised to find that Walter Martin, who wrote The Kingdom of the Cults, p.103, and John MacArthur both have or had rejected the Eternal Sonship of Christ for what they call "Incarnational Sonship."


BACK ON THE ROAD AGAIN

Closing all the "exit doors" is the key that exposes JWs and Mormons to the reality that they are lost without any hope. This should be the goal of every conversation with anyone who is lost.

Our next meeting was in Hazlehurst, Georgia where we met with two Mormon missionary girls and had a revisit with a JW family.

The Mormon girls were very polite until we challenged their "testimony" with the sings of the times. The one girl reacted same a James; she practiced and became belligerent and demanded that we leave immediately. The older JW couple were both sitting at the dining room table with their tablets studying for the Watchtower's Sunday morning question and answer session. We also did the John 1:3 checkmate with them. This led to who is Jehovah? and the five verses in Zechariah that identify Him as Jesus. Our next stop is NC to see Michael.
