Our church planter, Pastor Willy Edoloverio in Tapi, Kabankalan is doing a great work. The Lord is adding to the ministry there on a regular basis. He recently was able to lead a family to Christ and they are now faithfully attending. Bro. Willy and Sis. Kenneth just had their first child. Baby David was born this morning. Both mom and baby are fine. Sister Kenneth has faithfully continued in the ministry while expecting. She teaches weekly Values Education Classes in the local schools. They are currently building a Sunday School and Children's Church building. Bro. Willy has not asked for any help on this project but if we could raise any amount to help them, I am sure they would appreciate it. I would like to see the Lord enable us to raise \$2000 to help with this.

We are greatly anticipating the New Beginnings Baptist 13th Church Anniversary Revival and Church Planters Conference in Bacolod City, Philippines this September.
