JESUS GOD IN THE BEGINNING

In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth (Genesis 1:1).

Part of my job (the greatest one on earth) is to equip the saints to do God's work. Thinking of make ways to evangelism easy for you captures many hours of my "think time." God is so awesome, so powerful, so unsearchable so marvelous, so kind, so gracious, so longsuffering, so forgiving, so faithful, so near to those who love Him, that no group of unbelievers can put Him in a box and limit who He is or what He can do. That is precisely what cult leaders do. They create false gods, who they like, and then convince their followers to worship them. All false religion is simply idolatry. When Jesus spoke to the religious leaders of His day, He left them speechless. The power of God's Word still has that same effect today and will have forever. Did you ever notice how many times Jesus silenced His enemies? Here is one example that I have seen work on JWs the same way it did here: Matt 22:41-46: 41 While the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them, 42 Saying, What think ye of Christ? whose son is he? They say unto him, The Son of David. 43 He saith unto

them, How then doth David in spirit call him Lord [God], saying, 44 The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, till I make thine enemies thy footstool [Ps 110:1]? 45 If David then call him Lord [God], how is he his son? 46 And no man was able to answer him a word, neither durst any man from that day forth ask him any more questions. The implication of this text is clear. The Messiah would be both God and Man. The JWs also go away with the same conviction and silence as the Pharisees. This is also true with John 1:1-3 and Genesis 1:1. What did God do in the beginning? The composite expression of John 1:1-3 is that Jesus, in the beginning, created all things. That's it in the "nut shell." So you might ask the next JW you see this question: "Do you (the JW) know that why I know for sure Watchtower's John 1:1c (a god) is not correct?" The JW will say, "How?" You can say, "Because Genesis 1:1 says that God, not a god, created the heaven and the earth." Be sure to have the JW read Isa 44:24. Next, then the five verses in Zechariah that identify Jesus as Jehovah.

KEEP THEM COMING LORD

Contacts with JWs, Mormons and this time a Muslim man and his young daughter is what we pray about continually. It all started in Hazlehurst, GA, with a sit-down talk with a JW man and his wife, then a visit to two Mormon female missionaries and then back to the Atlanta area for two meetings with a JW family (husband, wife and daughter in her 20's).

While doing my walking exercises at the Mall of Georgia, I saw a tall, darkskinned Muslim doing his prayer ritual on the second level with his prayer rug like he was in the mosque. Just then, a security guard stopped by me and I asked him if he was allowed to do that in the mall. He said that he would take care of it. I sensed that the Muslim man was simply trying to intimidate people. On my way around the loop, I saw him walking down the corridor with his young daughter, and when we exchanged glances, I reached for my little card with the 10 Commandments on it and asked him if he believed in them. I hoped that the Lord would touch his daughter's heart with something that was said. I asked him if he had ever broken any of the commandments and he said, "No!" I replied forcefully by saying, "You mean to tell me that you never lied to your parents as a child?" Again he insisted that he had never broken any of Allah's commandments. Then he mentioned his prophet, Mohammad. His little girl was listening. I said that Mohammad is no different than the Mormon prophet or any of the others. They created their own god and convinced their followers to believe in him. That's what is called idolatry. The truth is that pre-Islamic Arabs in Mohammad's day worshiped 360 gods and he simply reduced it to one, the moon god, Sin whose title was the most high or Allah. He said that he would rather answer to *Allah* rather than the Christian's God. I said, "Sir, you will have your chance to see the God who created the heaven and earth someday and it won't be Allah." Lord, please help that little girl to see the truth.

THESUNDAYSCHOOLBOOK(TSSB)

I just got a letter from a pastor today who said that he believed God has great things in store for TSSB. One pastor said that he was going to have a meeting with his Sunday school teachers to encourage them to be certified. Seven young people (ages 8-12) have been certified for lessons 1-3.
