Much property has been destroyed, but praise the Lord, as of this writing he did not claim a life, at least from what I have been told or read. Our hearts have been heavy for people we have grown to love, and we wish we were there to give them comfort that can only be found in God's Perfect Word. Please pray that hearts will be turned towards God.

It is hard to believe that we are to the point of moving to Belize. We are thankful to see the hand of God personally moving things in place. I wish to allow part of this letter to focus on some opportunities that have come our way.

First we wish to thank both the Trinity Baptist Church of Arlington, Texas, and the Victory Baptist Church of Holly Ridge, North Carolina, for adding our family to their missions outreach program. We are currently at 85% of our needed support!

The summer months of deputation are typically slow months, but it has been really busy for us. We assisted in our church's annual Vacation Bible School. Several children were saved and the leaders did a good job. This summer the Lord has placed upon my heart the desire to assist church planters throughout the USA. We were able to spend a couple of days with the James Mansfield family who are church planters in Commerce, Texas. We were able to assist in a few things around the church. While we were in Sanford, Maine, I was

also able to assist Pastor Todd Bell by going soul winning with him. We were able to witness to three people, but only two were saved. Please pray for the Holy Spirit to work in their lives.

Last, allow me to share with you some exciting opportunities the Lord has allowed us to have. Initially when we move to Belize we will be moving to a city called Orange Walk Town to work with a veteran missionary. His family has built a house on the property where the church building sits, which means the house they were living in is now vacant. After speaking with the landlord, he has agreed to rent the house to us for only \$400 U.S. The house is very spacious, and it will allow me to also have an office. There will be more announcements in coming months, just pray for the Holy Spirit to lead in all matters. We have a couple of different opportunities to plant an English speaking church in a couple of locations.
