Dear Praying Friends,

We had two summer day camps, one at the beginning of August and the other at the beginning of September. We averaged 16 children at each camp. A few of the children were different, but most were the same.

Fane and Daniela continue to attend. They originally attended our church back in 2002, which was about a year after the church began. They made professions of faith, were baptized and became members of the church shortly thereafter. They had helped us a lot with VBS, camp, and Christmas ministries. But about nine years ago, they moved away and had not been attending anywhere since. So we are still trying to assess their spiritual condition, and we are hoping that they will once again be a big help to the ministry.

We had mentioned that Dana (Donna) from Biruinta (a nearby village) had been attending. Unfortunately, she moved out of the area, and we are no longer able to bring her to church.

Please continue to pray for Bogdan. We believe God is working on his heart, but he just doesn't want to give in.

We have some good news. Over the past several months, three children have prayed for salvation. The first one is a nine-year-old girl, Denisa, who is from a large family and a few years ago, one of her older sisters had prayed for salvation. The second is a 12-year-old girl, Sibel, whose mother is Romanian Orthodox and her father is Muslim. The third is a 13-year-old boy, Gabita. Shortly after Gabita prayed for salvation, he asked Bob, "Now that I'm saved, what do I do now?" This is the first person who has ever asked us this question.

We received some disappointing news in regards to the sale of the church building. The man who promised to buy the building has now changed his mind. Please pray that we will be able to find a buyer for the church building. This delay has been a hindrance to our ministry.

One of our vans needs a new engine. It may be less expensive in the long run to buy another van than it would be to buy a new engine. We are currently looking and assessing the situation. Please pray for wisdom regarding this matter.

Marianne has had a lot of health problems over the past four-five months. Please pray for her health needs.
