We praise the Lord that four people trusted Christ as their Savior during the revival meetings! I was also privileged to attend a traditional dowry ceremony – *now that was an experience!*

The Bible college is moving forward very well, and we are prepared to begin classes in January. I had the opportunity to speak to the pastors at their recent annual conference meeting and present to them in detail the training they can receive. *Many of the pastors have had no formal training*. It appears we may have 20 - 30 students. I will most likely have to teach in two separate locations because it is so difficult for them to travel. The picture I have inserted is of Pastor Dahn Demey, Missionary Walt Willets, and myself. Bro. Willets sponsored the education of Pastor Demey and other pastors several years ago. Today, Bro. Demey pastors one of the largest Baptists churches in Monrovia and has a radio station that reaches millions daily (*I continue to do my weekly program: "The Hour of Truth"*). He also sponsored Bro. Edwin Gbor, who pastors the largest Baptist church in Ganta. They were also able to repair the home of blind women and continue to reach out into the community. It will still take a great amount of time and expense before everyone can return to their homes.
