NO GREATER LOVE THAN CALVARY'S LOVE

Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends.

Living in a world filled with bickering, dishonesty, and moral decay among people who have rejected God and His Word gives Christians a great opportunity to focus on the grandest theme of all Scripture, Calvary's love. These are some of the words that support this truth: For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly 7 For scarcely for a righteous man will one die: yet peradventure for a good man some would even dare to die. 8 But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us (Rom 5:6-8). God the Father took Calvary's love with Calvary's blood and made it possible for as many as received His Son to be forgiven and cleansed from every sin. O blessed Lord, how wonderful is Thy love that has been shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which has been given unto us. Every person who has truly been born-again is experiencing this love by the presence of the Holy Spirit. Experiencing Calvary's love has this effect

Experiencing Calvary's love has this effect upon its subjects: *We love him*[God], because he first loved us (1Jon 4:19). Then also this effect: *And this commandment*

have we from him, That he who loveth God love his brother also (1Jo 4:21).

The next step in the love circle is seen here when Jesus said to Peter that if you love Me, there's something that I want you to do: *Feed my lambs and sheep!* Then the Lord told His disciples to go into all the world and proclaim the gospel, to disciple believers, and be ready at His coming.

Keeping oneself in the love of Christ is one of the greatest challenges a believer faces during his pilgrim journey here below. Here are some verses that encourage us to keep our affection on Him: Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life (Jude 1:21). Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins (1Jon 4:10). It is still Calvary's love that melts the cold, cold hearts of the lost as they see Christians loving one another and reaching out to them with the message of the gospel.

After arriving in NH, the pastor took me on two visits. We visited a Polish man who was raised Catholic and did not want to talk, but the Lord touched his heart and we had a good conversation ending with the thought, "You don't want to die knowing that you are lost, right John?" Then we visited a JW lady in her mid-70's. Wow! After about an hour of showing her checkmate points, she hugged my neck and said we could come back.
