
PRAYER LETTER JUNE 2017 The Hendricks Family



June 30, 2017

Greetings once again in Jesus name. We are currently in summer here in North Carolina. In the last two months we have not been in as many prison services because of our being in the Islands for 31 days. We did have a good Revival at Lincolnton Correctional Center this month. We had three great nights, as well as, visiting the yard, passing out tracts one day and serving the entire camp snow cones on Saturday morning; which gave us the opportunity to put a Gospel Tract into each man's hand as well as a smile on their face. The services were well attended with many getting help. There were at least 3 men who raised their hand lost but did not get saved. Please pray for them. In our other meetings, we saw 4 more men saved. Praise God.



While we were in Grenada, we were able to go into a Juvenile Center there. Pastor Michael Lambert goes there each Friday to work with the young men and women. It was a blessing to go there twice and preach to them. Many raised their hand to accept the Lord as their Savior. Brother Lambert will follow up on them in the weeks ahead.



We flew into Barbados early April 21. We were met by Brother Earl James. We spent the next three days there seeing the Island, as well as, preaching for him in the Church and in an Open Air Meeting. They were truly a blessing to Becky and I while we were there. It was good to see what God is doing there.





We left for Grenada, Monday morning, April 24. We arrived in the afternoon and started a Tent Meeting for Brother Lambert that night. It went through Friday night. We saw people on the altar each night getting help. There were at least 3 saved in the tent that week. TO GOD BE GLORY.

One of our greatest blessings was to see some of the ones who were saved in our ministry, when we lived in Grenada from 1992-1998, come to spend time with us and see them now with families of their own serving God. Fruit that abounds to your account. Amen.

The rest of our time in Grenada was spent in visiting all of our men there, preaching in their churches, seeing the works and helping a few days in building and clearing land. Brother Presley Felix is in the process now of building Anchor Baptist Church. They are in need of moneys for material. The men of the Church are building it as they have the money. Please pray for this need. We also went with Brother Celestine one day to work on clearing land for Heritage Baptist Church in Chocolate City. They still need about \$15,000.00 to finish paying for the land there. We were able to spend a little time with each of our men there during those days.



We left Grenada on May 12 and flew to St. Vincent. Brother Claudius Harry met us there and took us to the Ferry to go to the Island of Bequia for 4 days. We were met there by Brother Timothy Mitchell. I preached for him on Mother's day and had a great time getting to know him and his dear family. I took the Ferry back to St. Vincent and spent the last days there again meeting our men and seeing the Island and the needs.

We are hoping to send 3 barrels this year to our men. We would love to fill them with King James Bibles, Gospel Tracts, Sunday School materials and VBS materials. The price of each barrel, plus shipping, will be about \$200.00 each plus the cost of filling them. If you would want to help with any of these or if you have some King James materials that we could send them, please feel free to contact me. Thanks in advance for your help.
