I was very excited to learn that one of the churches I work with has started a Bible study in a new area. This Bible study was started without the help my help. It has been meeting on its own for a few months before I was asked to join. Questions ranged from marriage and family issues to the teachings of other religions to traditional African beliefs. The people are looking for the truth and have many questions. Please pray the Lord will send more laborers into the field to help show people the truth!

Our family is doing well. Two of our girls had birthdays in September. They are growing up so fast. It is amazing to see them pick up the Bemba language and have an interest in learning more about the culture around them.
