Jon Barr, SWM president, and I filmed several more lessons of Creation to Christ for Minimal Language Deaf around the world. These lessons, 40 so far, are already being used on at least 3 continents. All 40 lessons have already been shown to deaf people in Cambodia, and God's blessing their deaf ministries there.

Vicki and I traveled to several churches in the last 2 months. We spent a week with 3 of our missionary appointees representing SWMI at Ambassador Baptist College. What a joy to to impact others for missions.

Grace Baptist Church in West Columbia, South Carolina honored us for our 40+ years of Deaf Ministry during their annual missions conference. Our picture now hangs on the wall in their HALL OF FAITH of missions, and a new Bible was presented to me. We are grateful for the years God has given us to serve Him around the world!

Vicki and I also took a two-week vacation to celebrate our 40th wedding anniversary, and for rest. We visited the Creation Museum, the Ark Encounter, and other attractions, visited the church where my father was pastoring when I trusted Christ at the age of 6, visited a church that my grandfather pastored back in the 60s, besides meeting with old-time friends along the way. Truly, we are blessed to serve God together these 40 years.

(7) Day-to-day administrative duties and financial responsibilities with SWMI.
