DO YOU WANT TO BE LIKE THAT TREE?

And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper (Psa. 1:3).

This psalm has made an impact in some way to everyone that has read it. It has no author ascribed to it other than the Holy Spirit Himself. It gives each reader the opportunity to want to be the person who resembles this tree. The *tree* is a figure of speech that is called a simile. A simile uses the words *as* or *like* to compare the object to what it resembles. Here is an example that is often quoted: Isa 53:6, *All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.* If you want to be like that tree in Psalm 1, you can be: you just have to have **a good case of the "want to** be's."

The first want-to-be person that comes to mind is Hannah. Hannah was a woman that was barren and childless. She had a good case of the want-to-be's and became like the tree in the simile. Hers is one of the greatest life stories, filled with tender and touching moments that can move one to tears and then to overwhelming joy. This is none other than our Loving Saviour and Lord, Jesus Christ touching the lives of those who cry unto Him until His compassion is opened like a flood gate. If you're like me right now, your heart is leaping for joy and praise, for like Hannah we know how faith and love for His Word have made His presence real in our lives. The next want-to-be person is David. Perhaps no other person ever had the want-to-be's like he did. He wanted to have a heart like God.

Don't we all? Aren't we weary and tired of slipping and falling along the road of life? Don't we long for a heart that is void of sin and self a heart that is like our Lord's? Acts 13:22 And when he had removed him [Saul], he raised up unto them David to be their king; to whom also he gave testimony, and said, I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after mine own heart, which shall fulfil all my will. Perhaps this verse shows why the Lord said that David wanted His heart: Ps 17:15, As for me, I will behold thy face in righteousness: I shall be satisfied, when I awake, with thy likeness. My list could go on and on, but we'll conclude with my favorite person and gospel writer, John. Nothing grips my heart more than a good love story. John's is the most compelling to me. He

had a want-to-be that became a reality. As far as I know, the Lord only spoke a stern rebuke to him one time when he and James wanted Him to call fire down from heaven in Luke 9:54.

John was close to the Lord because he wanted to be. Isn't that the same with all of us? The Lord equated love with obedience. Not a legalistic or a self-righteous obedience, but rather a loving and willing obedience. He said if you love Me, keep my word and have it abiding in you. Isn't that what Psalm 1 is saying? We live in a world filled with bitterness and hatred because of sin. Let's each of us have a good case of wanting-tobe like Jesus. He is the Tree, the Tree of life.

Trinity= A word used to speak of the eternal relationship of the members of the Godhead-God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. The simplest expression of this truth can be given by the answer to this question. How could one explain the



trinity? It is the belief that God is one eternal being in three eternal persons. It can also be expressed in this manner: In the Godhead there are three Persons. Each Person is fully God. There is only one God. The Bible supports this statement doctrinally.

The Father is called God (John 6:27) Labour not for the meat which perisheth, but for that meat which endureth unto everlasting life, which the Son of man shall give unto you: for him hath God

life, which the Son of man shall give unto you. For this hard <u>seew</u> the Father sealed. Jesus is called God (John 1:1) In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the <u>Word</u> [title for Jesus] <u>was God</u>. The Holy Spirit is called God (Acts 5:3-4)3 But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to <u>lie to the Holy Ghost</u>, and to keep back part of the price of the land? ... why hast thou conceived this thing in thine heart? <u>thou hast not lied unto men</u>, but unto Cod but unto God.

1 Tim 2:5 For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;

I Thess 5:3 And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ
