


## **October/November Prayer Letter**

As we quickly approach the Thanksgiving and Christmas seasons, Sarah and I are constantly reminded of God's love, grace, and mercy in our lives. The past few months have been very busy for us. We have driven many miles on the road between meetings and mission's conferences, yet we are never too busy or too tired to give praise and thanks to our great God. Sarah and I concluded our western states swing just last week and are now back on the east coast for the remainder of the year. We thank the Lord for His protection on the road over the thousands of miles we have driven! While out west, we were in four meetings in California, six meetings in British Columbia (Canada), and one meeting in Colorado. These meetings were such a blessing to us and we are very thankful to have been able to share our field of Gambia with these dear churches. Also, during the past few months we have seen God do some wonderful things at the churches we have been at. We have seen young people in youth groups and schools commit to living their lives for God and even some burdened for becoming a missionary! We have also seen two people come to know the Lord as their Savior in the past few months. What a joy it is to see a life forever changed by the saving grace of Jesus Christ! Some of the ways in which God has allowed us to serve in the churches we have been in recently is soulwinning, bus ministry, and school chapels. While out door-to-door soulwinning with a church recently, I was able to talk with a man for about 30 minutes about the Lord. While he did not trust Christ that day, I was able to give him a clear presentation of the Gospel as well as information about the church we were at. Sarah and I also recently were able to be part of the bus ministry at a church. We greatly enjoyed singing songs with the kids that were being picked up for church and telling them about Gambia. And finally, one of the greatest joys recently has been the opportunity to preach and teach to Christian school students. From K5 to high school students, we have loved the opportunities recently to speak at several schools during mission's conference weeks. What a joy it has been to challenge those students about living their lives for God and serving Him with all their heart. Our prayer is that God would call several of those students to surrender their lives to serve on a foreign mission field someday...maybe even West Africa!


