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STAYING FOCUSED AND BEING THANKFUL

If ye know these things, happy are ye if ye do them (Joh 13:17).

they might have had opportunity to have returned. 16 But now they desire a better country, that is, an heavenly: wherefore God is not ashamed to be called their God: for he hath prepared for them a city.

Before continuing, we want to assure you that we will be voting on election day because it is our privilege and duty. Yet, regardless of the outcome, whether it was what we were hoping for or not, we know for sure these three things about God's will for His Pilgrims. First, we know how God wants us to live. *We are to live by faith and by every word that proceeds from His mouth: Rom 1:17, ... The just shall live by faith. Matt 4:4, ... Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.* Second, we know what God wants us to be. That is the salt of the earth and the light of the world (Matt 5:13-14). Phil 2:15 ... *Be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world.* Third we know what God wants us to do. *Go into the world and preach the gospel with repentance and remission of sins in His name among all nations and teach and disciple all believers so they are equipped for the work of the ministry (Matt 28:19-20; Mark 15:15; Luke 24:47; Eph 4:11-13).*
