RECENT EVENTS

On the second of March we headed out for what would be a two and a half month road trip starting out in Tennessee. During the missions conference in Tennessee we received news that our pastor's wife passed away after an eight month battle with cancer. We left there and went to Florida to be with our pastor and church family for the memorial service. The Lord gave great grace to our pastor as he preached an excellent salvation message and reminisced on the 48 years he had with his wife. We then headed back to North Carolina for a couple more missions conferences and two other meetings in Virginia. On the fifth of April after a two day reprieve at home, we left for Ohio to begin a long stretch of meetings across Ohio, Canada, Michigan, and Indiana. The end of April we drove around 1,200 miles from central Ohio to West Palm Beach, Florida in two days to be in a missions conference with a church Joel had presented in three years ago who invited us to return. We then made our way to Joel's parent's house in northwest Florida for a couple of weeks of family time and meetings in their area.
