We thank the Lord for each of you co-laboring with us in this ministry of IBOM-ASIA. God is working throughout Southeast Asia and it is exciting to see and hear of His dealings in the hearts of man.

Saya (Bro) Edward in Mandalay recently had the privilege of leading this 82-year-old man to Christ. His name is U Htun Taung. His wife passed away six years ago from leprosy and now he has it as well and is not expected to live too long. He told Saya Edward "Pastor, I may not be able to make it to your church because I am too weak to go far away from my house, but I promise to see you in heaven!" As tears streamed down his face he smiled and said "Yes, I will see you in heaven."





On July 20, 1816 Adoniram Judson printed the first edition of his Burmese

Gospel tract on A View of the Christian Religion. Our team located a copy of this tract and have it ready to be reprinted. We can have them printed in Myanmar and save on the shipping costs and avoid the difficulty of getting them into the country as well. This is a ten-page booklet, printed in color on good quality paper. The cost is \$1000 for 10,000 copies. I would love to see the Lord provide the funds to get this tract printed for the 203rd Anniversary of its original printing and have

an evangelistic campaign on July 20, 2019.

At right is the Judson Translation of the Bible in the Burmese language. This was the first translation of the Bible for the Burmese people. We can purchase these quality Bibles in Yangon, for \$6.00 each. We currently have 17 churches and 3 orphanages in Myanmar. I would like to raise the funds to purchase at least 1000 Bibles. The people in Myanmar need to have the Word of God in their homes to grow in His grace. Please pray for these literature needs so we can continue to make a difference in Myanmar.





Lastly, I ask that you **pray for our son Andrew Murray**. Andrew has graduated high school and is seeking God's will for his life. He is prayerfully considering sports management and missions.
